."It Takes A Village to Raise a Wall" premiered at the Del Mar Library Dedication Ceremony on June 7th. Del Mar TV community producers and first time documentarians, Nicole Holliday & Tracy Phillips debuted the 30 minute video on two monitors during the event.

Holliday and Phillips worked closely with artists Pat Welsh and Betsy Shultz during the 10 month process, insuring they captured the politics, the labor and the passion that go into a public art project. "The artistry that went into making the wall motivated us to work so intently on this video," recalls Holliday. Both producers agreed, "editing was the most difficult

task. We had almost 20 hours of video and some very touching interviews with people who had donated sentimental items to the wall project.

The Del Mar Television Foundation initially funded "It Takes A Village". The Historical Society, The Wall Fund and the Del Mar Village Association provided subsequent funding.

Along with it's San Diego Fair award Payasada Horseplay also won a national award at the Hometown Video Festival. Not bad for our little group.

Our own DMTF Productions continues to take on increased activity this year. We continue to strain our budget this year with ever more new programs. Underway just this month (June), we are working on; Payasada Horseplay for 2003, Summer Solstice at the Del Mar Plaza, the Texas Toothpicks musical group at the Del Mar Art Center at the Plaza, the Harry Potter Magic Show at the Del Mar Library and the first Powerhouse Park Summer concert. That's a lot to pull off in one month, but with the help of many, I'm sure we will do it.

This month we started a new film series, it's meant for night owls, but you can see the new classic films on Tuesday afternoons. Each month has a different theme. Check out the great selections (on the front page), they are films that are not normally seen on DMTV66. Hope you got a chance to see the WWII series by Frank Capra, it's a great documentary. If you missed it, check the schedule, it will be repeated.

One other note on the San Diego Fair videos, once again, this is the third year, we will be showing all of the winning videos from this years Fair on DMTV66. Donna Cosentino, the Fair coordinator for eArts, gives the tapes to us right after the Fair closes, so we will be showing the winners starting in July.

Our grant programs is on track for this year. There still is plenty of uncommitted funds available, so if you think you have a great idea for a show, submit a grant request. The form is available on the web and at the DMTV studio. We have some pretty experienced producers around that I'm sure would be happy to answer any questions you might have on what it takes to put on a production.

The website is do for some more upgrades. We will be adding more forms to the Producers Group section of the site to help producers apply for and process grants. Forms to be added are; Talent Release form, Grant Agreement form, Grant Funds Release form. Also to be added to the site is the Producers Showcase Criteria.

I can't believe the Community Calendar went live over a year ago. The Calendar can be seen at [www.delmartv.com/calendar](http://www.delmartv.com/calendar), on DMTV 66's daily bulletin board and as an insert to the Sandpiper Newsletter. The Calendar Consortium is planning to expand the capabilities this year by adding email contact directly to the sponsoring organization. More upgrades are also planned, but that will come later.

The Producer's Showcase rolls on. It continues to provide a place for old (not by age) and new producers to hone their skills and come up with new ideas. We are working on a plan to get more Del Mar resident, with interesting stories of course, to be the talent for the Showcases.

Hope you told your, outside of Del Mar, friends to take a look at the expanded distribution of our programs on Time Warner (channel 19, Thursdays @ 7pm) and Adelphia (channel 3, Monday @ 8:30pm).
