



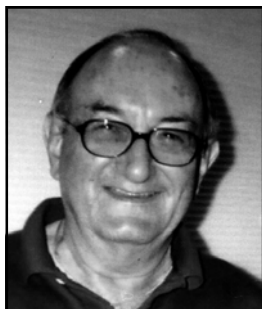

In January, after six years as the President of the Del Mar TV Foundation, Pete Glaser stepped down.

On February 4, Nicole Holliday took over the position and wrote an article for the Del Mar Times newspaper entitled "A Warm Thank You to Pete Glaser."

After certification, he worked on crews for eight local public Access TV stations, ultimately producing his own programs. Pete moved to town in 1985 and worked for a short time as cameraman at the station but couldn't involve himself wholly until he officially retired in 1996. During Pete's reign as President, over 70 programs were produced. DMTV won over 20 awards and DMTV Foundation has raised \$100,000.

He recognized the importance of Public Access and worked hard to bring local programming to Del Mar residents.
